- ▶ **International** – Topics and themes cover nonreligion in Africa, the Arab World, East Asia, South Asia, and Central and Eastern Europe as well as in North, Central, and South America.
- ▶ **Exploratory** – Monographs and edited volumes are concerned with the forming and reforming of religious traditions in relation to their cultural and political contexts, the establishment and maintenance of boundaries, and modes of differentiation.

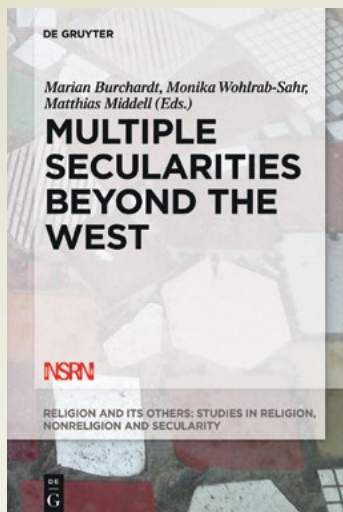

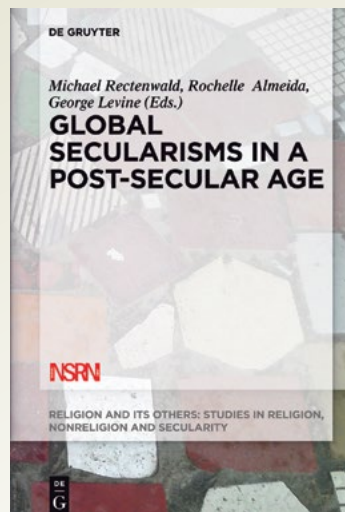

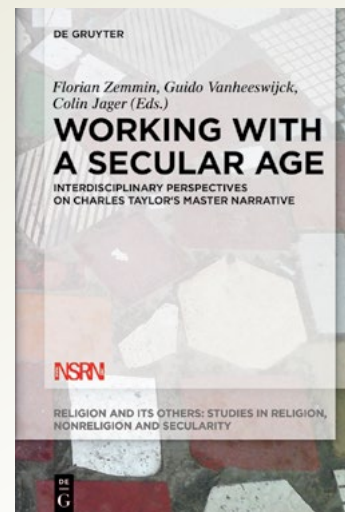
